The latest amendment to the FLSA established a minimum wage of \$6.55 an hour until July 24, 2009, when it will be raised to \$7.25 an hour. Every increase in the minimum wage requires congressional approval. Federal minimum wage law is enforced by the Wage and Hour Division (WHD) of the Department of Labor.
